### BRONCOS BEAT BENGALS TO IMPROVE TO 3-0

The **Denver Broncos (3-0)** earned their third consecutive win the start the season by beating the **Cincinnati Bengals (1-2)** in their first road contest.

This marks the second consecutive season—and 14th season overall—the Bronco have started 3-0.

### SIEMIAN HAS MONSTER GAME IN FIRST ROAD START

Broncos **QB Trevor Siemian** completed 23-of-35 passes (65.7%) for 312 yards with four touchdowns (132.1 rtg.) against Cincinnati to become the first player in NFL history with 300 passing yards, four passing touchdowns and zero interceptions in his first career road start. Sunday marked just the third time any Broncos quarterback has reached those totals in a road game. The two previous occurrences were by **Peyton Manning** during his 2013 MVP season.

Siemian is now 3-0 as a starter to join **Craig Penrose** (1976, '78) and **Brock Osweiler** (2015) as the only players to begin their NFL careers with three consecutive wins as a member of the Broncos.

### MISCELLANEOUS GAME NOTES

- \* - Denver's game captains were **C Matt Paradis** (offense), **CB Aqib Talib** (defense) and **K Brandon McManus** (special teams).
- \* - For the first time in three seasons (at Stl., 11/16/14), the Broncos had a 300-yard passer (**Trevor Siemian** – 312) and two 100-yard receivers (**Emmanuel Sanders** – 117; **Demaryius Thomas** – 100).
- \* - Broncos **OLB Shane Ray** posted a career-high three sacks in his first NFL start; coupled with **OLB Von Miller's** three sack performance last week, this marks the first time since at least 1982 that two different Broncos have posted three sacks in back-to-back games.
- \* - **WR Cody Latimer's** 46-yard kickoff return in the second quarter was the longest such play by the Broncos since **S Omar Bolden** returned a kickoff 76 yards vs. Oakland on Dec. 28, 2014.
- \* - The Broncos were +1 in the turnover margin to win their NFL-best 25th consecutive game when winning the turnover battle.
