

OPSkins Privacy Policy

What Is the Purpose of our Privacy Policy?

OPSkins ("we", "our", "us") takes your privacy seriously. Please read this Privacy Policy carefully to see how OPSkins will treat the personal information that you provide to us either when using the OPSkins website and any other websites, mobile and other applications or services that post a link to this Privacy Policy (each a "Site") or in other circumstances when we collect data from you (including via email). We will take reasonable care to keep your information secure and to prevent any unauthorised access or use of it.

How Will You Know if our Privacy Policy Changes?

We may change this Privacy Policy from time to time and the change will take effect once the revised Privacy Policy is available on this Site. The "last revised" date is at the bottom of this Privacy Policy. Therefore, please refer to this Privacy Policy each time you submit your personal information.

What Information Do We Ask You to Provide?

We may ask you to provide information to us or collect data from you on different occasions, including at a number of points on the Site, such as when you purchase our products or services, e-mail us about your interest, purchase or use of our products or services, or register to receive or download information, newsletters or other documentation.

The information that you are asked to provide will vary depending on the reason for the collection. In some instances, for example, if you purchase goods or services from us, the provision of certain information will be mandatory.

As we require individuals to be 18 years or older to buy or sell items on the Site, we do not seek to collect information from individuals younger than 18.

Please note that if you choose to participate in any discussion forum on the Site you may disclose personal information about yourself to other participants. If you do so this is at your own risk.

How Do We Use Your information?

We will use your personal information to respond to your enquiries, to send information to you, to fulfil any contractual obligation to you, for research purposes, to send marketing information to you in accordance with the provisions set out below; or for other reasonable purposes for which you have provided such information.

If you become a customer of ours by purchasing goods or services from us we may send you further information that is related to your purchase, by post or e-mail.

We would like to send you marketing information, by post, e-mail, or SMS. By providing your information you are agreeing to OPSkins contacting you in this manner to provide you with such marketing information in accordance with the terms of this Privacy Policy.

In addition, our affiliated companies and selected third parties would like to send you marketing information, by post, e-mail, or SMS. We will only allow them to do this if you have indicated that you

consent to receive such information.

If you do not wish to receive any of the above information or be contacted by us in accordance with the above, please update your preferences online or alternatively write to OPSkins at the address below.

If you submit your views to us via our contact form we may circulate them internally for training and management purposes.

We may aggregate the information you send to us with other data (so that you cannot be identified from that data) and use that aggregated data for administrative purposes and/or share it with other people.

With Whom Do We Share Your information?

We will share your information with our affiliates and third party service providers if this is necessary or reasonably required for any of the purposes above. Such third party service providers are not entitled to use your information for their own purposes.

We may also share your information with third parties for marketing purposes as described above if you have consented to receive such information. Some of these third parties may be located outside of the Isle of Man or United Kingdom, including in countries where data protection laws might not exist or be of a lower standard than the EU.

How Do We Protect Your Information?

We are committed to protecting your privacy and we implement various security measures in relation to our processing and transfer of personal data. However, the nature of the Internet is such that the data may in some circumstances flow over networks without full security measures and could be accessible to unauthorised persons.

How Do We Use Cookies and Similar Technologies?

When you visit the Site, we may collect, process and use information about you which may not personally identify you but which may be helpful for improving the operation of the Site, such as “cookies.”

A cookie is a text file that stored on your computer. As text files, cookies cannot read information on your hard drive, run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies let our Site remember your preferences or recognize you when you return. You can delete cookies or configure your computer to reject them, although this may disable the Site’s ability to manage individual sessions.

As do many internet sites, we gather other information automatically, such as Internet Protocol (IP) addresses, browser type and language, Internet service provider (ISP), referring and exit websites and applications, operating system, date/time stamp, and clickstream data.

There are “do not track” or similar browser choices available to internet users with respect to online web activity, but given the present lack of consensus of what constitutes an informed election, appropriate trigger or breadth of scope of such choice, our Site will not operate any differently when a “do not track” signal is received.

We Are Not Responsible for the Privacy Practices of Third Party Links

This Site may contain links to other sites. Please be aware that we are not responsible for the privacy practices of these sites. We encourage our users to be aware when they leave this Site and to read the privacy statements applicable on those sites. This Privacy Policy does not apply to information collected on third parties' sites.

How Can You Access the Information We Collect?

You have the right to access the information that OPSkins holds about you in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998. In order to do this please make a written application to OPSkins at the address provided below. OPSkins may require you to provide verification of your identity and to pay an administrative fee (which is currently £10) to provide a copy of the information that it holds.

If you are a US California resident, you may have the right to request and receive certain information about a company's disclosure of your personal information to third parties for their own direct marketing use, and your choices with respect to such disclosures. California Civil Code Section 1798.83 permits users of the Site that are California residents to request certain information regarding our disclosure of personal information to third parties for their direct marketing purposes.
